








New & Improved myASE

Spanish Translation for ASE Tests

Since January 2020, selected ASE professional certification tests have allowed test-takers to view test questions in Spanish translation. As of January 2021, several tests were added to that number. Tests A1 through A8 in the automobile and light truck series, as well as the automobile maintenance and light repair test (G1) allow a side-by-side Spanish/English rendering of each question with answer options by clicking on the "Leer en español" button. Keep your ASE Certifications current

Join the over **8,800** current technicians who validate their technical knowledge with **ASE's Renewal App**, available on their desktop, tablet, or mobile device.

Do you know technicians who are certified in A1-A9? Did you know they can maintain their current ASE certifications without having to step foot in a test center?

How it works: Answer one question per area per month on your mobile device and once you answer 8 questions correct, your ASE Certification for that area will be extended by one year.

First-time, currently certified subscribers: You will get an initial 1-year extension when you first subscribe to the ASE Renewal App. Then, after you earn 8 credits per area, you will earn an additional year when you get 8 credits

Try it before you buy it. Sign up for a free 3-day trial. After your free trial has ended, sign up for the annual subscription at \$48/year for any or all the automobile series (A1-A9) certifications. The \$48 price is the same whether you are certified in one area or all nine.

A Few Reminders



30-Day Wait Period

If you take an ASE test and receive a "Pass" or "Fail" test result, you must wait 30 full days before you can purchase and schedule the same test again.



Test Centers

Testing at Prometric test centers can be scheduled online by logging in to the myASE portal. Testing at a Prometric Satellite test center requires contacting the site directly to schedule a date and time in most cases.



Reporting

Although the new myASE portal does not currently include all the functionality that the old portal offered, we are working to add more features as we move forward into the new year.



myASE Username and Web Browser Compatibility

Log in with your existing username for accounts created before August 1, 2020. For new accounts created after August 1, 2020, your username is your email address.

The myASE portal is supported on all web browsers with the exception of Internet Explorer.



Tests for Military Technicians

ASE has teamed up with the U.S. Military to create tests for novice, intermediate and advanced technicians who maintain and repair military tactical wheeled vehicles. Successful passers will receive an ASE credential which will serve as proof of their competence. The intermediate series of tests includes Diesel Engines (MIL2), Drive Train (MIL3), Chassis (MIL4), Suspension-Steering and Hydraulics (MIL5), Electrical/Electronic Systems (MIL6), HVAC (MIL7), and Preventive Maintenance Checks and Services (MIL8). The first two tests in this series, MIL2 and MIL6, were introduced in January of 2021. Military, as well as vehicle manufacturer subject matter experts are involved with ASE in the development process for these tests. The credentials are available to all technicians (military and civilian) who pass the test and have at least two years of experience working full time as a technician. The intermediate tests are administered at Prometric and ASE satellite test centers. ASE is targeting 2022 for the introduction of the novice and advanced tests.

The ASE Military Tactical Wheeled Vehicle Certification program can be used to earn promotion points for military personnel. Technicians and their employers can use test results to develop individual training plans tailored toward areas that require improvement. Additionally, the credentials can also strengthen transitioning Soldiers' marketability in the civilian job market by validating and certifying Soldiers' trainability and knowledge of vehicle system fundamentals and diagnostic procedures.

ATMC Training Benchmarks Survey 2020


The mission of the non-profit ASE Training Managers Council is the advancement of training and professional development within the transportation service industry. In support of this mission, for nearly a decade, the ATMC has conducted an annual survey of training providers and technicians. In 2020, a record number of individuals (6,234) responded to the survey, providing important information on such topics as average age of transportation service professionals, employer types, pay structures, training realities, and training needs.


"This data-driven approach will help the industry identify gaps between training being offered and what technicians say they need," notes ATMC President Dave Milne. "By analyzing and applying this survey information, training content and delivery can be targeted more effectively to training consumers, for the benefit of the entire transportation service industry."


